

RAFFLE RULES AND REGULATIONS

AFC's World of Chocolate Raffle ("Raffle") is being conducted by the AIDS Foundation of Chicago ("AFC"), a not-for-profit charitable organization. The Raffle is being conducted pursuant to the Illinois Raffles Act, 230 ILAFC 15/0.01 et seq., and the Cook County Code, to raise funds for ongoing charitable purposes. The World of Chocolate Raffle Official Rules and Regulations (the "Official Rules") are set forth below. By purchasing a Raffle ticket (a "Ticket"), the purchaser acknowledges that they are aware of, and agrees to be bound by, these Official Rules and AFC's interpretation of any such Official Rules. AFC shall be responsible for interpreting and applying the Official Rules. AFC's interpretation and application of such rules shall be final.

Eligibility: Any individual who is 18 years of age or older at the time of the purchase of the Ticket is eligible to enter the Raffle. AFC's employees, their respective spouses and children living in the same household are excluded from participating in the Raffle and are ineligible to win a prize. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. The Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

How to Enter: Raffle tickets may be purchased for thirty dollars (\$30) for three tickets; Fifty dollars (\$50) for seven tickets; or one hundred dollars (\$100) for twenty tickets by eligible persons (see above) from October 17, 2017 10:00 a.m. CT until December 7, 2017 12 a.m. CT. There are three (3) ways to purchase raffle tickets: Only one (1) eligible person may be entered in the Raffle per Ticket sold. If the name of more than one (1) person is provided on a Ticket entry form and that Ticket is selected as a winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed as the holder of record of that Ticket and declared the winner. The division of any prize among a group of persons purchasing a Ticket in common shall be the sole responsibility of the person named as the holder of record of that Ticket should that Ticket be selected as a winner. AFC is not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise from different individuals listed on a winning Ticket.

Tickets will not be sold after December 7, 2017. Tickets may sell out before that time. An individual can purchase as many Tickets as they may wish, subject to availability.

Tickets may be purchased:

By the Internet. Visit www.aidschicago.org/chocolate and click on "purchase tickets." Follow the instructions to complete the order form and submit payment.

By Mail. Send completed form to the AIDS Foundation of Chicago, 200 W. Jackson Blvd., Suite 2100, Chicago, IL 60606.

By Telephone. Call 312-334-0935 and provide the information requested by the representative.

All entries must include payment by check, money order, cash or credit card. AFC reserves the right to reject any entry form that is submitted without proper payment or payment that does not constitute "good funds." No refunds will be made except under the following circumstances: any ticket order with payment received after December 7, 2017, will be returned.

Any physically altered entry form, or entry form received without proper or sufficient payment, will be immediately disqualified by AFC. Neither AFC nor its directors, officers, employees, agents or other representatives assumes any responsibility or liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible or undelivered entries, or any other failure to receive entries, or any failure to deliver a receipt of purchase prior to the drawing deadlines.

Prize Drawings: Prize drawings will be conducted by a representative of AFC on December 8, 2017 at the AIDS Foundation of Chicago office. Entrants need not be present to win. Winners will be selected at random.

All orders for Tickets must be received and/or purchased by the indicated deadline to be eligible for the applicable drawing. AFC assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or fax messages, or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines.

Notification of Winners: Winners will be notified according to the contact information provided to AFC at the time of Ticket purchase. If a selected winner is unable to be contacted or located after a period of one (1) month from the draw date of the applicable raffle drawing, the prize or its cash equivalent will be deemed to have been donated to AFC.

In order to collect a prize, a winner must sign and deliver to AFC: (a) such written information as is required by any applicable tax and/or real estate laws, including, without limitation, Social Security Number; (b) proof of identity in forms satisfactory to the AFC showing that the person claiming the prize is the same person who is named on the winning Ticket. Winners of prizes of \$1,000 or more may be required to submit a W-2G, Form 5754 or similar tax form (provided by AFC) for tax withholding purposes.

A list of winners will be posted on the Raffle website within one week of the applicable drawing.

Non-Deductibility of Ticket Purchase: The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently, the purchase of a Ticket does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.

Taxes: There may be federal, state and/or local tax consequences of winning a prize in the Raffle. Any and all taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Purchasers of Tickets are advised to consult their own tax advisors with respect to tax liabilities that may arise from winning a prize in AFC Raffle. Winners of prizes of \$1,000 or more may be required to submit a W-2G, Form 5754 or similar tax form (provided by AFC) for tax withholding purposes.

Terms and Conditions: The Raffle is subject to these Official Rules. These Official Rules cannot be changed by any oral statement made by any employee, consultant or agent acting on behalf of AFC. By entering the Raffle, entrants accept and agree: (1) to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of AFC which shall be final and binding; (2) waive any right to claim ambiguity in the Raffle or these Official Rules; and (3) that AFC may use the entrant's name, photograph, likeness, statements, biographical information, voice, and city and state address for promotional or advertising purposes in connection with the Raffle on a worldwide basis and in all forms of media, now or hereafter known, in

perpetuity, without review, permission or further compensation, except where prohibited by law. Other rules and regulations may apply. Please contact AFC if you have any questions. AFC Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

BY ENTERING AFC'S RAFFLE, EACH ENTRANT RELEASES AFC, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR INJURIES, LOSSES OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ATTORNEY'S FEES) CAUSED BY PARTICIPATING IN THE RAFFLE OR WINNING ANY PRIZE OR RESULTING FROM ACCEPTANCE, POSSESSION, USE OR MISUSE OF ANY PRIZE, AND EACH WINNER AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD AFC HARMLESS FROM ANY AND ALL LOSSES, DAMAGES, RIGHTS, CLAIMS AND ACTIONS OF ANY KIND ARISING FROM, IN CONNECTION WITH, OR AS A RESULT OF PARTICIPATING IN THE RAFFLE OR THE WINNER'S ACCEPTANCE OR USE OF ANY PRIZE.

A RAFFLE ENTRANT'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR ANY CLAIM AGAINST AFC ARISING OUT OF THE SALE OF TICKETS OR THE CONDUCT OF THE RAFFLE SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE RETURN OF THE PURCHASE PRICE PAID FOR THEIR TICKET(S). IN NO EVENT SHALL AFC, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS OR REPRESENTATIVES BE LIABLE TO ANY PARTY FOR ANY LOSS OR INJURIES TO EARNINGS, PROFITS OR GOODWILL, OR FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY PERSON OR ENTITY WHETHER ARISING IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

ANY CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE RAFFLE OR THESE OFFICIAL RULES SHALL BE SETTLED BY BINDING ARBITRATION ADMINISTERED BY THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION (PURSUANT TO ITS EXPEDITED PROCEDURES) UNDER ITS COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION RULES AND CONDUCTED IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS. JUDGMENT ON THE AWARD RENDERED BY THE ARBITRATOR MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY COURT HAVING JURISDICTION THEREOF.

Cancellation/Termination of Raffle: By purchasing a Ticket and choosing to participate in the Raffle, each Raffle participant acknowledges and agrees that AFC has the right, in its sole discretion, to elect not to proceed with the Raffle for any reason whatsoever or for no reason, and in such event, a participant's sole and exclusive remedy shall be to receive a refund of the full price paid by such participant for each Ticket purchased, without interest.

Registration with the State of Illinois: AFC has registered with the City of Chicago under Raffle License Number 2036673. The Raffle License Number will be published in all marketing materials where possible.
